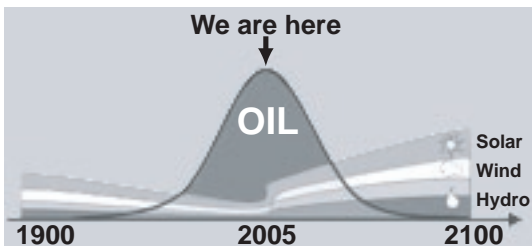


ARE WE ADDICTED TO OIL?
